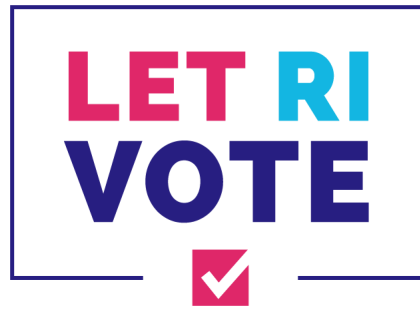

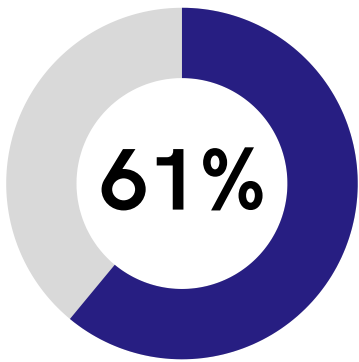

CURRENT LIMITATIONS:

- Rhode Island has a 30-day voter registration requirement written in our constitution
- Rhode Island currently allows eligible residents to register and vote up to and on Election Day for president and vice president only

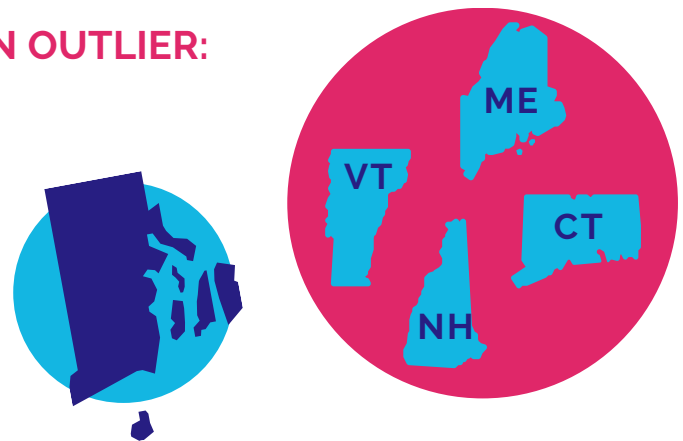
SAME DAY REGISTRATION:

- Allows eligible residents to register and vote a full ballot up to and on Election Day
- Improves voter list accuracy
- Decreases provisional ballots
- Eliminates arbitrary deadlines
- Reduces racial inequity and increases overall voter turnout

RHODE ISLAND'S VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE IS THE MOST RESTRICTIVE IN U.S.

RHODE ISLAND IS AN OUTLIER:

Same-day voter registration is already available in 4 of 6 New England states
